**Dr. William D. King** is a Clinical Instructor in the Dept. of Infectious Diseases at UCLA. He was born in Inglewood California and raised in Los Angeles. He received his BA in Cellular Molecular Biology at California State University at Northridge in 1989. He graduated from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign's Medical Scholars Program in 1996 receiving dual degrees in medicine and law. Dr. King completed his internal medicine residency at Cambridge Hospital in 1999 and his Chief Residency in 2000. For the past four years, Dr. King has been affiliated with UCLA where he completed the UCLA Robert Wood Johnson Clinical Scholar Program in 2002 and is currently completing a post doctoral clinical fellowship in HIV clinical care and research with the Department of Infectious Disease. His main research interests are in racial inequities and disparities in care and in community based research in domestic and international settings.
